Chuck Ruedi and Guy Reece are leading effort to develop Health Code changes on septic enforcement and alternative solutions that are 100% enforceable and monitored. 8. State Park / ORV Improvements/DNR/DEQ

The Board discussed:

- the ongoing concern of the dunes encroaching on private property at the end of North Shore Dr.;
- > concerns about the proposed removal of trees in the pedestrian lot and what likely will be the acceleration of dune movement;
- > and concerns about pedestrian access from the parking lot to Silver Lake, etc.

There was also discussion of possibly meeting with Liesl Clark the new head of DEQ in Lansing. Her email address is ClarkL20@michigan.gov and her phone number is 517-284-6712. It was suggested to work through Senator Bumstead. This meeting should follow the meeting with Kasey Mahony.

Concerns were also expressed regarding dredging at the State Park boat launch, signage needed to expedite movement, determine if there is a way for persons to drop off boats that don't need parking spots when the parking lot is full and possible wash station for boats coming into the lake to avoid evasive contaminations. Also, of concern is the matter of trash in the dunes and repair of the ropes for used to keep the public off of private property.

Jim Baumbick and Ron Bell have agreed to send Silver Lake State Park Manager, Jody Johnston, a letter regarding these matters.

9. Bike Lanes on Roads Around Silver Lake

Bill DeJong shared with the board a draft of a letter to be sent to Golden Township, Oceana Road Commission, and Larry Byl Oceana County Commissioner regarding problem of the bike lanes on Silver Lake Road and North Shore Drive. The lack of maintenance is causing excessive growth that is blocking the lanes and sand and gravel which is causing persons to be walking and riding their bikes in the streets. This is a safety concern and we are requesting that this be addressed, and future paving include proper preparation and paving of the bike lanes.

Motion to submit letter to Oceana Road Commission, Golden Township and Oceana County Commissioner Byl. Moved by Jim Baumbick, seconded by Ron Bell. Motion passed.
