- <u>Silver Lake Carp Cull</u> Discussion took place concerning holding a Carp Cull on Silver
 Lake this Spring to reduce the population of this invasive fish. Hayden shared what had
 been learned to date. Bly, Dykstra and Elrod were enrolled to assist is further planning,
 with the event likely taking place when the fish are spawning in the shallows along the
 shoreline in late May/early June.
- <u>Boat Launch Signage Install</u> Informational signs concerning invasive species transfer between lakes have not yet been received but are expected yet this Spring.

Movies in the Park – Through the early Spring email appeal FoSL has raised \$1,750 toward this project. Potempa is investigating potential rental equipment for this Summer.

New Business -
